This year's summer camp season of our Archdiocese will begin on **June 21** and close in **July 19**. **THIS YEAR WE WILL GO BACK TO THE UKRAINIAN CAMP** in Emlenton PA. The camp address is following: 110 All Saints Road, Emlenton, PA 16373. "**The Sacraments and Salvation: Holy Confession and Holy Communion**" will be this year's theme. The program includes participation at morning and evening services, dance, painting icons on glass, music and Romanian language classes, reading and opened discussions, sport activities like swimming, volleyball, soccer, hiking and more.

The schedule for four weeks of camp is as follow:

-First group **June 21 to July 5 -ages 16-18** and **ROYA groups**, ages 18-25.(The campers will arrive Saturday June 21 after 3pm and they will leave not later than Saturday July 5 before 12pm)

-Second group **July 5 to July 19 -ages 7-15**. (The campers will arrive Saturday July 5 after 12pm and they will leave Saturday July 19, before 12pm)

Please do not delay. **The cost is \$550** per two weeks/person. **The kids under 7 yo WILL PAY \$510** per two weeks/person and they must be accompanied by one of the parents or legal guardian who will pay full cost. Past years participation of kids under 7 yo was free but now several changes in the renting contract were added by the Ukrainian Camp. The meals will be prepared by the Ukrainian camp. Applications received after June 15, 2013 will be assessed a \$50.00 late processing fee. Email or phone reservations are not accepted. Please note that space is limited to 60 campers per group.
