In the beginning, the Living Church was created...

- 1947 Leduc Oilfields were discovered and many people, including Romanians of the Boian district came to find better fortunes in Edmonton.
- 1948 "Saints Constantine and Elena" Romanian
 Orthodox Congregation of Edmonton was organized by
 few romanians who made a pledge that the Orthodox
 Faith, which sustained them in times in difficulties, must
 and will be defended.


- 1952 The Romanian Orthodox Congregation of Edmonton, "Saints Constantine and Elena", was registered.
- People met for services from time to time, in the basements of the people's homes, whenever they had a priest coming from Boian, Regina or elsewhere.
- Since the beginning, they wished to have a church and decided to collect money and start building a church, so it will be easier to get a priest to serve them.

1962 - after Bingo was held and collections were made, the land for the church was purchased.

1965 - decision to build a hall, so it could be rented and more money could be made for the new church.

The Romanian Centre came into life.

1969 – His Grace Bishop Victorin, sent Rev. Fr. Mircea Panciuk in reply to the parish's request for a priest.

- each Saturday night the hall was cleaned after it was rented out and set up the chairs and all icons, and the make-shift altar for the Sunday Holy Liturgy.
- each Sunday evening, work to get it ready to be rented to the playschool on Monday.
- the Church of Romanians in Edmonton started a new era:
- partaking in services with other Orthodox Churches in Edmonton and Western Canada.
- organizing summer camp for children at Boian.
- opening Sunday School program.
- forming a choir with regular practice.
- forming a Youth Group and a Social Club.
- having a hard working Ladies Auxiliary group.



1970 - the parish in AGM decided to begin preparing the site for the new church.

1970 - after much deliberation, it was decided to build the church alongside the hall, as in the blueprints for the building of the hall from 1963.

The Moldavian architectural style was chosen, the style developed during Stephen the Great's time - a 500 years old architectural style added to a modern city in Canada.

The Romanian Orthodox Church of Edmonton 45th Anniversary

- March 14, 1971 blessing of the land was made by His Grace Bishop Victorin and a sobor of five priests, from other Orthodox Churches in Edmonton ("St. Barbara" Russian Church, "St. George" Greek Church, "Sts. Peter and Paul" Romanian Church of Kayville, Saskatchewan), and local representatives.
- It was a pan-orthodox service, held in four languages.
- Each present priest took a shovelful of ground from the spot where the Holy Table of Oblation would be, and a plane wood cross was planted - the first Romanian Orthodox Church of Edmonton was started!



- May, 1971 at the 23rd Church Anniversary, the basement had been almost finished and the sub-floor had been put on.
- After five months of construction, the church was crowned with the nine foot steel cross replica of the one that stands today atop of the Voronetz church in Romania - was placed at the top of the tower.
- The interior finishing of the church was done by the hard work of many parishioners: interior painting, 4000 sq. ft. of tile, solid oak pews, Bohemian Crystal Chandelier.



- Nov. 14, 1971 the first Divine Liturgy celebrated, with the blessing of His Grace Bishop Victorin.




The Romanian Orthodox Church of Edmonton 45th Anniversary

- Shortly after the consecration of the church, the first wave of immigrants from Romania arrived in Edmonton, a process that reached its peak in 80's, and still continues today.
- The new immigrants understood they have a role to play in the never-ending effort of upgrading and maintaining this place of spirituality and culture.
- And so, began a not always easy process of coexistence between the "old Romanians" and the "new Romanians".

 an addition was built, which constitutes of the stage for the main Hall, with the office area above it, and the spacious entrance to the church (the foyer), guarded by the bell tower.



• 2003 - the entire Altar was painted by the same iconographer.




2004 - the three archways between the vestibule and the church itself were built.




